

ClearPath Hires Jeremy Harrell As Policy Director

Former Heller energy aide joins growing D.C. office

WASHINGTON, April 25, 2017 -- ClearPath has hired Jeremy Harrell as policy director as part of the broader growth of the organization's Washington, D.C., staff and operations.
