

TerraPower's Announcement to Build Reactor in Wyoming is Huge for Advanced Nuclear

Washington, DC – Wednesday, June 2, 2021 – ClearPath congratulates TerraPower on its announcement to build a Natrium™ reactor demonstration project at a retiring coal plant in Wyoming, in partnership with PacifiCorp.

"Developing the next generation of nuclear technology *now* is so important as many of the largest utility companies in the U.S. are making big bets they will reach net-zero carbon dioxide emissions by 2050," **said Rich Powell, Executive Director of ClearPath**. "Without a large helping of nuclear power in the mix to produce needed clean energy, these bets are less likely and will certainly be more expensive."

TerraPower's Natrium™ reactor, along with X-energy's Xe-100 reactor, were selected in October 2020 as part of a goal to bring advanced nuclear technology to market with the Advanced Reactor Demonstration Program (ARDP), a program administered by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). In October, DOE awarded \$160 million to the two U.S.-based companies to build two advanced nuclear reactors that can be operational in the next seven years.

In April, X-energy announced a deal with Energy Northwest and Grant County Public Utility District to build X-energy's high temperature gas reactor in Washington state.
